




public and I thought that was a problem as I knew people interested in this matter that would have attended if they knew this very significant and substantial change was being made.

6. Copies of the proposed amended local law were not handed out at the public hearing, not available to the public, and it was very confusing what language was being added, especially since there seemed to be so many versions that were not shared with the public.
7. The Town Attorney and the Town Supervisor admitted that the change had only been made that day. Two Town Board members also stated that they were unaware of the proposed change to the noticed local law and did not see the amendment until that afternoon.
8. Amending the MC Overlay District description to include lands contiguous to the HVPC is a significant and substantial change to the potential reach of that District and reflects a substantive change to the elements of the MC Overlay District that was not properly noticed before the public hearing.
9. I am certain that if people were aware of the intent to extend the reach of the MC Overlay District more people would have attended the public hearing and commented on the effect of that change.
10. By not having advance notice of the full extent of the proposed amendment, I was deprived of my right to comment on the proposal.
